

## **Maputo Headline Inflation – January 2013**

## **Main Facts:**

- Maputo consumer prices continued to increase in January. According to figures from the National Statistics Office, the monthly inflation rate stood at 1.1 percent in January, from 1.0 in December.
- The end-of-period inflation rate increased to 2.4 percent (from 2.2 in December), while the average inflation rate further dropped to 1.9 percent (from 2.1).

• Inflation in January was driven mainly by increasing prices of food items and educational services. The table below shows the contribution of product categories to total price variation.
