

Presentation at the Finance and Economics Institute of Tajikistan on May 16, 2014

The IMF Resident Representative Office in Tajikistan continues to broaden its outreach to its various stakeholders, including government, civil society, legislators, and the private sector, to better inform on IMF activities and disseminate Fund views on key economic issues in Tajikistan.

On May 16, 2014, Mr. Aidyn Bibolov, the IMF Resident Representative in Tajikistan, delivered a presentation at the Finance and Economics Institute in Dushanbe as part of the outreach efforts. The presentation was widely attended by the faculty and students. The event was officially opened by rector of the institute, Mr. Ashurboy Soliev, who welcomed the IMF and noted its contribution to improving institutional and human capacity in the country.

The presentation focused on variety of issues ranging from general information about the Fund creation and its mission in the international financial system to special topics including IMF's role and activities in Tajikistan and country's recent macroeconomic developments.
