# South Africa - NEDLAC

- Act of Parliament
- All Laws affecting world of work tabled for consideration
- Sovereignty of Parliament intact
- Four Chambers and four ministries
  - Labour Market
  - Trade and industry
  - Public Finance
  - Development



# Where does Nedlac come from?

## Problems with these forums:

- ◆ Conflict between scope of different forums
- ◆ Lack of capacity lead to poor mandating and poor reporting-back

## Solution:

- ◆ Nedlac Act unanimously passed by parliament in September 1994
- ◆ Establishment of Nedlac in February 1995



# NEDLAC'S POWERS & FUNCTIONS

## Three broad objectives:

- ◆ sustainable economic growth
- ◆ greater social equity
- ◆ increased participation in economic decision-making at all levels

## Specific responsibilities:

- ◆ conclude agreements on and consider all significant changes to social and economic policy
- ◆ consider all proposed labour legislation
- ◆ encourage coordinated policy-making



# KEY FEATURES OF NEDLAC

- ◆ Statutory institution, funded from Dept of Labour budget
- ◆ Four partners -
  - ◆ Government, Business, Labour and Community
- ◆ No party has a formal/ official veto
- ◆ Mandated representatives of organised constituencies
- ◆ Agreement-making
- ◆ Independent secretariat administers the process
