South Africa - NEDLAC

- Act of Parliament
- All Laws affecting world of work tabled for consideration
- Sovereignty of Parliament in tact
- Four Chambers and four ministries
 - Labour Market
 - Trade and industry
 - Public Finance
 - Development



Where does Nedlac come from?

Problems with these forums:

- **♦** Conflict between scope of different forums
- Lack of capacity lead to poor mandating and poor reporting-back

Solution:

- Nedlac Act unanimously passed by parliament in September 1994
- ◆ Establishment of Nedlac in February 1995



NEDLAC'S POWERS & FUNCTIONS

Three broad objectives:

- sustainable economic growth
- greater social equity
- increased participation in economic decisionmaking at all levels

Specific responsibilities:

- conclude agreements on and consider all significant changes to social and economic policy
- consider all proposed labour legislation
- encourage coordinated policy-making



KEY FEATURES OF NEDLAC

- Statutory institution, funded from Dept of Labour budget
- ♦ Four partners -
 - ◆ Government, Business, Labour and Community
- ◆ No party has a formal/ official veto
- Mandated representatives of organised constituencies
- Agreement-making
- ◆ Independent secretariat administers the process

- Social Partners
 - Government
 - Employers
 - **■** Trade Unions
 - **■** Civil Society
- Millennium Labour Council
 - Bipartite = Employers + Workers
