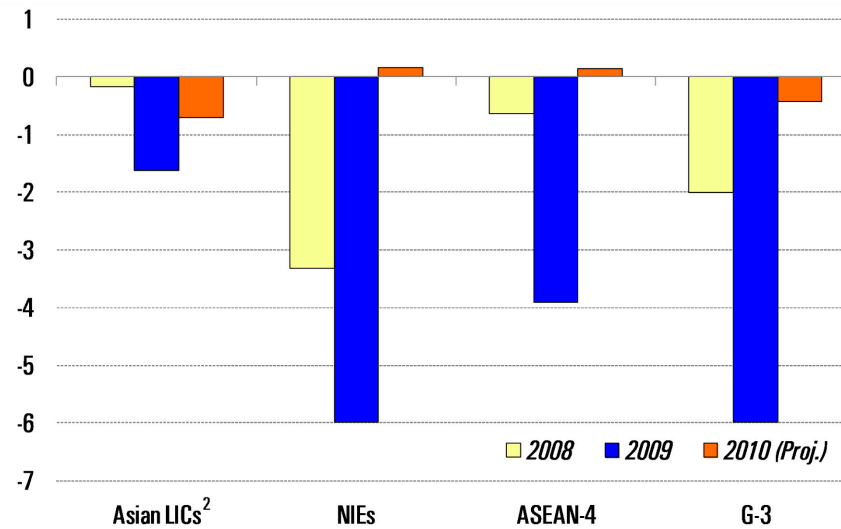


Real GDP Growth in Comparison with Pre-crisis Growth¹

(In percentage points)



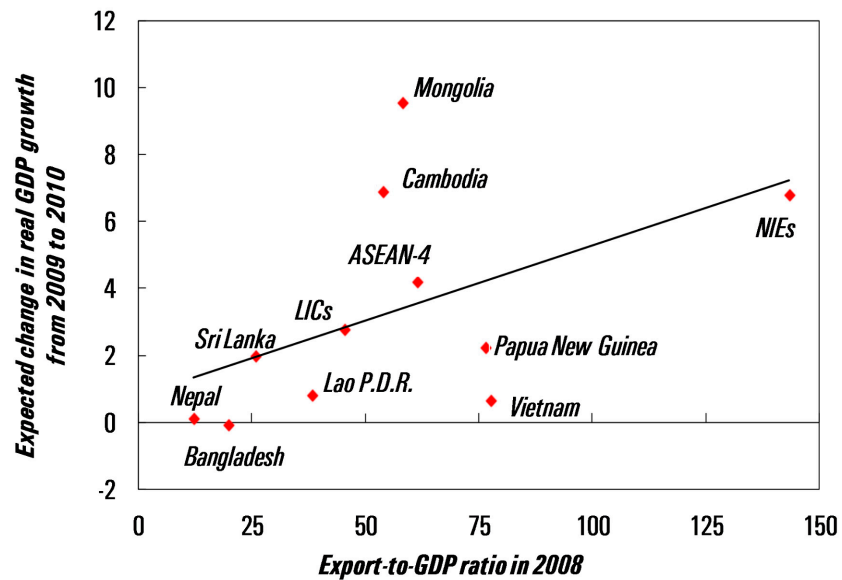

Export Dependence and Impact on Real GDP Growth

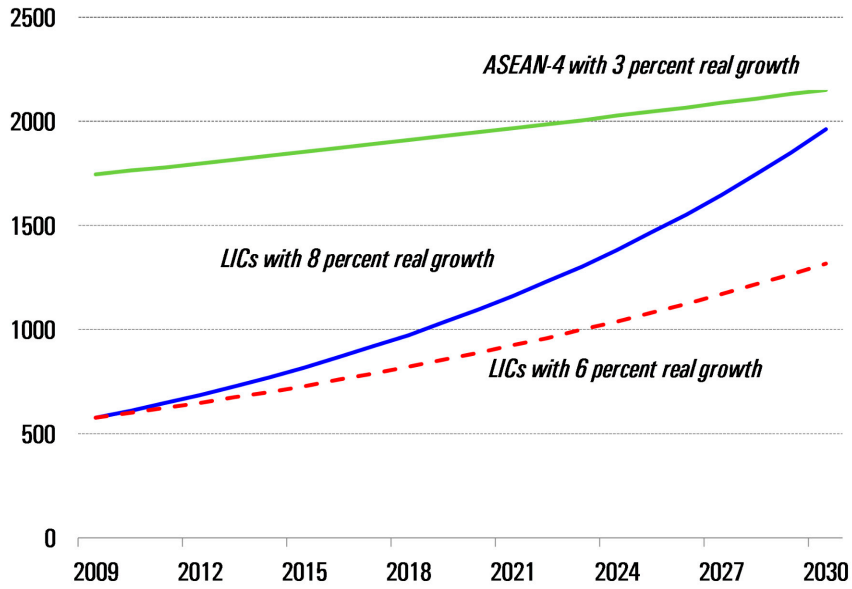

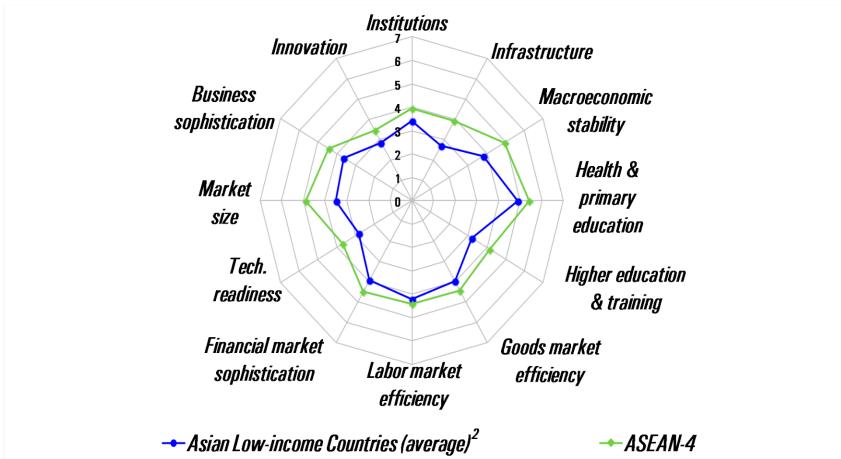
Illustrative Medium-Term Growth Paths
