ORDER No. 2024-1

“ZZ”, Applicant v. International Monetary Fund, Respondent (Withdrawal of the Application)

The Administrative Tribunal of the International Monetary Fund, having considered that:

- on January 5, 2024, Applicant filed an Application with the Administrative Tribunal, followed by a corrected version on January 16, 2024 (the “Application”); Respondent filed an Answer on March 4, 2024; Applicant filed a Reply on April 8, 2024; and Respondent filed a Rejoinder on May 9, 2024;
- Applicant requested anonymity in the Application, and Respondent opposed that request in the Answer;
- on September 3, 2024, the Tribunal informed the Parties that, unless they were to advise the Tribunal within ten days that they have come to an agreement on anonymity, the Tribunal would reject Applicant’s request for anonymity; and
- on September 16, 2024, Applicant informed the Tribunal of the withdrawal of the Application,

unanimously decides, without disclosing the identity of Applicant, to record that: (i) the Application has been withdrawn; and (ii) the proceedings before the Tribunal have accordingly been terminated.
