Dr. Hafiz A. Pasha is the Dean of the School of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences at the Beaconhouse National University, Lahore, and Vice Chairman of the Institute of Public Policy, Lahore. He is currently serving as Chairman of the Advisory Panel of Economists to the Planning Commission, Convenor of the Economic Advisory Council of the Prime Minister of Pakistan and Chairman of the Tax Advisory Council of Federal Board of Revenue.
