Recommendation II.17

The G-20 economies to publish residential property price indices consistent with the Handbook on Residential Property Price Indices (RPPI) and supply these data to the relevant international organizations, including the BIS, Eurostat, and OECD.

The IAG in collaboration with the Inter-secretariat Working Group on Price Statistics (ISWGPS) to work on a set of common headline residential property price indices; encouraging the production of long time series; developing a list of other housing-related indicators; and disseminating the headline residential property price data via the PGI website.

OECD quarterly house price indicators for 27 (+4)

OECD countries

IMF RPPIs included in SDDS Plus;

PGI website linked to BIS data set



Moving forward

Dedicated IAG Working Group on House Prices

Aim is the further alignment of

- RPPI headline indicators (including additional breakdowns)
- methodology for estimating long time series
- additional housing-related indicators against the background of the OECD proposal of a framework for data collection

Work on SDMX for price indices to be initiated



Moving forward

G-20 economies to provide house price indices in line with the recommendations of the RPPI Handbook, as well as housing-related indicators (template still to be decided upon)
